

This archive provides access to the original run of *Barron's* starting with the title's initial publication in 1921 under Dow Jones and Company. Named after Clarence W. Barron, an influential business journalist and founder of modern-day financial journalism, the newspaper served as a record of happenings on Wall Street and a glimpse into the world of finance.




African Commons is a project to digitize, enrich, protect, and disseminate African cultural content. The database will offer access to African archival finding aids, a global directory of collecting institutions with African holdings, and a hosting and discovery service for full-text publications and primary sources, with a mix of freely available and paywalled content.

Archives Unbound's 29 new or forthcoming collections cover broad areas of interest across Africa, Asia, Europe, the Middle East, and the United States. Coverage includes decolonization in Africa in the 1960s, the archives of the Works Progress Administration (later Works Projects Administration), British Home Intelligence Reports from World War II, and more than 300 cookbooks printed from 1669 to 1990.

This database replaces the Canadian Electronic Library and is produced in partnership with Trojman Corporation.

With several hundred more resources than the CINAHL (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature) Full Text, Plus, and Complete collections, this collection covers more than 50 nursing specialties and provides access to scholarly and evidence-based research, quick lessons, care sheets, continuing education units (CEU) modules, and research tools, as well as a wide range of international content.



Geared toward policymakers, scholars, and health leaders, this open-access resource accelerates peer review of COVID-related research across a wide range of disciplines. These rapid peer reviews of time-sensitive preprints cover public health, medical sciences, biological and chemical sciences, humanities and social sciences, and physical sciences and engineering.

This resource builds off the success of Rapid Reviews: COVID, an open-access overlay journal that accelerates peer review of COVID-related research preprints. Expanding beyond COVID-19 to the larger field of infectious diseases, this database aims to prevent the dissemination of misleading scientific information and accelerate the validation and diffusion of findings.

## HISTORY

**Africa and New Imperialism: European Borders on the African Continent,**

**1870–1914. Adam Matthew. [amdigital.co.uk/products](http://amdigital.co.uk/products)**

Drawing on rare printed works, diaries and journals, correspondence, maps, photographs, films, and more, this is an essential resource for the study of the major impact of European colonialists and imperialist regimes on the communities across the African continent.

**American Historical Periodicals from the American Antiquarian Society, Part 7. Gale. [gale.com/primary-sources/american-historical-periodicals](http://gale.com/primary-sources/american-historical-periodicals)**

Part 7 of the American Historical Periodicals series contains over 650,000 pages of periodicals, mostly from the 1840s through the early 1900s, covering the gamut of U.S. historical topics. Many are illustrated or oversized periodicals that have been digitized here for the first time.

**British Library Newspapers, Part VI: Ireland. Gale. [gale.com/primary-sources/historical-newspapers](http://gale.com/primary-sources/historical-newspapers)**

This newspaper collection includes 220,000 pages from 108 national, regional, and local Irish newspapers printed from 1783 to 1950. These papers complement and provide a counterpoint to the predominantly English and Scottish perspectives in British Library Newspapers Parts I-V.


This video resource comprises approximately 7,000 early 20th-century *Topical Budget* newsreels drawn from the British Film Institute (BFI). These silent films, which reached a weekly audience of up to five million, offer fascinating insights into British life, with subjects ranging from the First World War to sport, leisure, and fashion.

**British Society, 1939–1951. Coherent Digital. [coherentdigital.net/brho](http://coherentdigital.net/brho)**

Sourced from the the National Archives, UK, and the History of Advertising Trust, British Society, 1939–1951, documents stories told through the eyes and words of women, children, refugees, and other groups often underrepresented in historical accounts. Researchers will be aided by summary notes, a table of contents for each file, and detailed subject indexing.

**Cold War Eastern Europe. Coherent Digital. [coherentdigital.net/cwec](http://coherentdigital.net/cwec)**

Cold War Eastern Europe, sourced exclusively from the National Archives, UK,



allows students and researchers a look into the workings of every country in the Eastern bloc during the post-Stalin era, through thousands of English-language insights written in the first person by officials of the time.

**Colonial Caribbean, module III: Economic Change and Indentured Labour, 1850–1870. Adam Matthew. [amdigital.co.uk/products](http://amdigital.co.uk/products)**

This final module in Colonial Caribbean studies a turbulent period of economic decline and uprising. The documents, drawn from the National Archives, UK, explore the rise of labor by indentured Chinese and Indian workers against a backdrop of injustice and poverty in previously enslaved communities.

A digital archive of more than 25 serials relating to the later period of the British Empire and the Commonwealth, with particular focus on independence movements and decolonization.

**Conflict in Indochina: Foreign Office Files for Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia: Section I: Crisis and Upheaval, 1959–1964. Adam Matthew. [amdigital.co.uk/products](http://amdigital.co.uk/products)**

Comprising FO 371 class government papers from the National Archives, UK, the first module traces the political crisis and growing conflict experienced by the region. There is extensive coverage of the regimes and internal political situations in Vietnam, Laos, and Cambodia, and increased American military intervention in Indochina.

**Decolonization: Politics and Independence in Former Colonial and Commonwealth Territories. Gale. [gale.com/primary-sources](http://gale.com/primary-sources)**

Drawn from British university archives, this collection holds 300,000 pages of political ephemera (pamphlets, reports, speeches, and more) in 70 countries from 1898 to 2017, with a post-1945 focus. These primary sources explore decolonization as a historical process, revealing changing British imperial and colonial structures as well as decolonization and postcolonial politics.

**Digital National Security Archive: The Afghanistan War and the U.S. (1998–2017). ProQuest. [about.proquest.com/en/products-services/dnsa/](http://about.proquest.com/en/products-services/dnsa/)**

Covering the key periods of the 20-year U.S. war in Afghanistan, this timely collection provides researchers with a trove of revealing primary documents, chiefly from the Bush and Obama years.

This collection focuses on printed material attempting to maintain law and order through laws, ordinances, edicts, and political tracts throughout war-torn early

modern Europe. There was also much debate around the concepts of peace and how it could be achieved and maintained for the well-being of the state and the individual.

The *London Evening Standard* focused on the social narrative of and for the “man on the street.” This collection contains an almost uninterrupted run of the *Standard* and *Evening Standard* from 1827 to the present day. Coverage of notable events includes the American Civil War, the Falklands War, the Armistice, and the Blitz.

Part of ProQuest’s historical newspapers collection, the Observer Magazine Archive provides access to the digitized contents of one of the most renowned pictorial newspaper magazines. Founded in 1964, the *Observer Magazine* contains historically significant writings, visuals, and color photographs from renowned photographers, serving as a rich source of primary source content.

The Americans for Democratic Action Records trace the evolution of the organization as it supported civil rights, the united international control of atomic energy, and global democracy. The collection contains records of campaigns on vital issues such as the civil rights movement, disarmament, the Vietnam War, inflation, and unemployment.

**History Vault: Joint Chiefs of Staff, Early Cold War, 1946–1960. ProQuest. [about.proquest.com/en/products-services/historyvault/](http://about.proquest.com/en/products-services/historyvault/)**

This collection will contain documents of the Joint Chiefs of Staff from the Early Cold War, 1946–1960. This collection will launch in 2023.

**Interwar Culture, module II: 1930–1939. Adam Matthew. [amdigital.co.uk/products](http://amdigital.co.uk/products)**

The second module of this resource showcasing popular and lesser-known periodicals tracks the dramatic cultural shift of the 1930s. Against a backdrop of the Great Depression and the rise of fascism, the 1930s

also witnessed a renewed and fierce appetite for entertainment and culture through film, art, and literature.

**1980s Culture and Society.** Adam Matthew. [amdigital.co.uk/products](http://amdigital.co.uk/products)

Users can compare grassroots media with official records to explore political, social, and welfare issues of the 1980s such as the rise of conservatism, nuclear threat, and the AIDs crisis. This database offers a host of secret intelligence files, previously undigitized materials from a range of British government sources, including Cabinet Office papers and daily signals intelligence reports. Designed to assist students and researchers with in-depth study of how wars were conducted day by day.

Materials from a wide range of sources, sent to the British Foreign Office by embassy staff, spies, and others, document the rise of fascism in Germany from 1919 to 1939. The bulk of the material is in English and includes contemporary summary reports written by government officials.




online content offerings. The platform lets users save notes, navigate video chapters, rewind, and more.

This archive presents the entire, 125+ year collection of the U.S. edition of *House Beautiful* from 1896 to the present. As the oldest American shelter magazine still in publication, *House Beautiful* serves as a record of the history of interior design and the impact of cultural and societal trends on design, such as women's roles, family life, and consumer behavior.

These archives allow users to explore how the works of William Shakespeare and his contemporaries have been adapted, interpreted, presented, and understood since the early twentieth century. This resource contains 1,400 prompt books, complemented by photographs, original designs, sheet music, and production records for its most innovative productions.

Topics include examination of the stated justifications for war, military engagement, human rights, environmental damage, oil policy, and attempts to influence Iraq's postwar governance.

This resource allows access to the International Secretariat records of Amnesty International. Users can explore the rise of the global human rights movement during the second half of the 20th century and trace the history of key political events, social change, and campaigns. Themes include political prisoners, minority rights, and more.

This public-policy database offers 3.4 million reports, white papers, policy briefs, data sources, and media, plus a searchable directory of 24,000 intergovernmental and nongovernmental organizations, think tanks, and research centers worldwide. This planned add-on module to Policy Commons will provide access to more than five million pages of reports, surveys, planning documents, and research drawn from more than 600 North American cities and urban agencies. The database includes and expands on the Index to Current Urban Documents and preserves these often-ephemeral documents for posterity.

**Political Extremism and Radicalism, Part III: Communist and Socialist Movements around the World.** Gale. [gale.com/primary-sources/political-extremism-and-radicalism](http://gale.com/primary-sources/political-extremism-and-radicalism)

Forthcoming in March 2023, this collection (the third in a series on political extremism and radicalism) covers radical



left-wing movements worldwide from 1766 to 2004. Primary sources, including books and periodicals, letters, pamphlets, and organizational records, shed light on a range of leftist ideologies, responses to the Russian Revolution, the Red Scare, and more.

**State Papers Online Colonial: Asia, Part 1: Far East, Hong Kong, and Wei-Hai-Wei.** Gale. [gale.com/primary-sources/state-papers-online](http://gale.com/primary-sources/state-papers-online)

This collection of 3,700 manuscript volumes, totaling 390,000 pages dating from 1570 to 1967, records British administration and governance of East Asian territories, international relations across the period, and the changing demographics and daily life of the territories' inhabitants. Part 1 of this Asia-wide series focuses on China. Files come from the British Colonial Office.
